Residents can pick up meals EITHER:



EMERGENCY MEDICAID

Assistance for undocumented individuals

YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAID (PE)

Requirements: includes but not limited to:

- have no documentation from the U.S Citizen and Immigration Service; or
- Are non-immigrant (students, temporary workers, or children of a worker or visitor on business; or
- Are a qualified alien who is subject to the 5-year bar* on Medicaid, such as lawful permanent residents, aliens granted
 parole for a least one year, and certain victims of domestic violence. (this 5-year bar does not apply to children and
 pregnant women)
