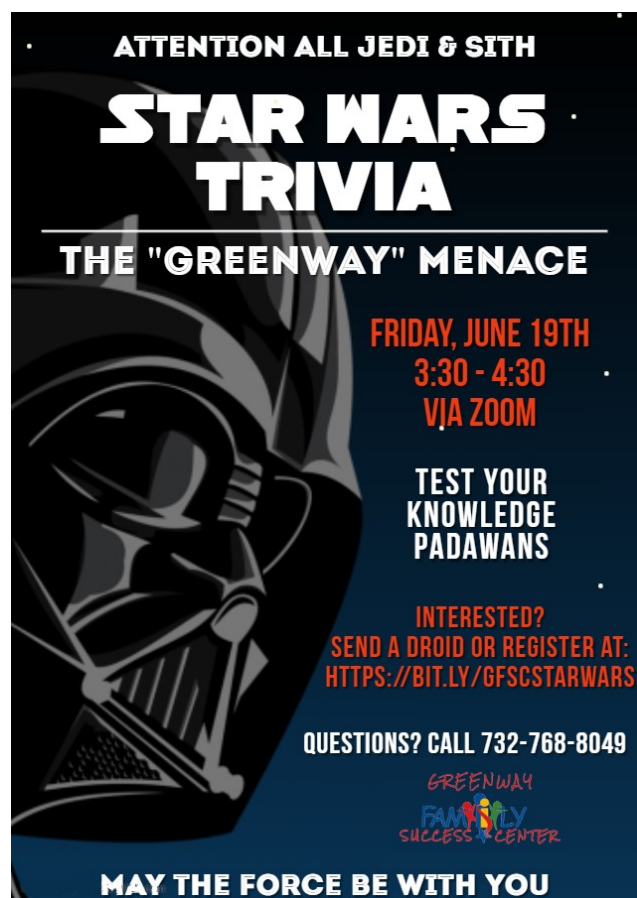

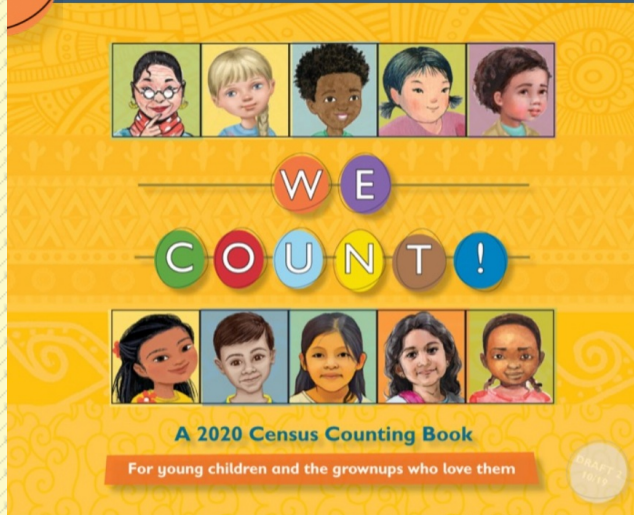

## COVID-19 Short-Term Rental Assistance Program

The COVID-19 Short Term Rental Assistance Program will provide temporary rental assistance to low- and moderate- income households that have had a substantial reduction in income or have become unemployed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. More details will be published on June 15<sup>th</sup>, and the application will open in July. The program will offer an initial three months of temporary rental assistance, with the ability for the household to renew for an additional three months if needed. Approximately 20 percent of the rental assistance funds will be reserved for homeless families impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

## Census Corner

The Census is a short questionnaire that you can fill out online, on the phone, or via mail. It's done once every 10 years to count EVERYONE who lives in the US – that helps the government figure out how much financial aid to give to each state for important things like **education, safe roads, and health care**. It also makes sure we have the right number of representatives representing our state. Plus, it's **totally confidential!** Your information is protected by law.
